Digital Certificate for Plant-A-Tree Donation

Plant-A-Tree is a National Reforestation and Forest Education Program run by the USDA Forest Service partnered with our National Garden Club.

Garden Clubs participate in this program by donating a minimum of \$50.00. In appreciation for the donation, National garden Club provides the donor Garden Club with a Plant-a-Tree donation certificate that is dedicated to "Honor" someone or "In Memory" of someone per donor Garden Club's instruction. As of May 31, 2025, National Garden Club will no longer provide Plant-A-Tree Donation physical certificates and will be moving to a paperless/digital alternative. This will not only be a better choice for our environment but donor clubs will get the certificates quickly and more efficiently.

Upon receiving the donation, the National Garden Club will email the donor garden club the following link to generate the digital certificate:

The digital certificates can be customizable and allow donor clubs to print out their own certificates.

Garden Clubs under GCFM will continue to make their donation of a minimum of \$50.00 or multiples of \$50.00 following the instructions below:

- 1. Have your club make checks payable to GCFM, Inc.
- 2. Complete the Plan-A-Tree Application Form that is available in GCFM Website.
- 3. Must provide a correct email address where the digital certificate will be mailed.
