We begin with "Things You Need To Know"

- Eligibility Open to all GCFM members from districts, clubs, or individuals.
- Deadline December 1st unless otherwise noted.
- Awards are presented for work in the 2025 calendar year.
- There are more than 50 award categories.
- GCFM also offers youth awards, scholarships (to garden club members and students) and grants to fund club projects.
