



Safeguarding Raptors from Rodent Poisons

Raptors (eagles, owls and hawks), coyotes, foxes, opossums, and domestic pets are being sickened and even killed after ingesting rodents who have consumed common rodent poisons. Massachusetts Audubon has developed a Rescue Raptors Toolkit as part of their Rescue Raptors advocacy program. This toolkit covers all aspects of this issue including alternative rodent control options.
