How to Write A Strong Awards Application

List as much as you can think of under each of these questions:

What happened?

Who was involved (club/community)?

Where, when, and how did it happen?

Why did you do it / why is it important (objectives)

What were the results of your work?

What difference did it make to the club and/or other communities or the benefactor?

Who will maintain the project (if applicable)?

NEXT

Divide your **list** under the requirements of the award!



START YOUR DRAFT!

Use a simple **Five Paragraph Essay format**! (Intro, three body paragraphs, brief conclusion) **Convince the reader** that YOUR CLUB should win this award!

Don't forget to **include your financials** in those three pages. (cost to club, any donations, grants, services received, and expenses)

Use your list so you don't leave out anything critical.

Then - Cut, cut, cut anything that isn't needed. Be clear and concise.

Don't get too fancy! Use a font that is easy to read: Times Roman, Cambria, etc. Use minimal underlining, bold, and graphics in the write up. Add photos, landscape plans, to your application narrative.

ASK other Club Members to READ IT to strengthen it and catch typos!



Not sure what to list under Project Expenses & Funding?

Funding:

Where and how much of the project funds will come from – the club, donations, businesses, grants, etc.

Expenses:

What did you purchase with those funds? How much did you spend on each item or each part of the project?



SUBMIT! SUBMIT! SUBMIT!

All applications and supporting documentation must be submitted **Digitally.**

Send application as a **PDF** or **Word document.** *Include* photos and supporting documents in *the narrative*.

Send via one email with subject:

"Your Club Name" + "Award Title"

by midnight December 1, 2023.

Please send submission for a different project or a different award in a separate email.



The **Criteria** for Judging Award Applications

5 pts - Presentation

All sections included and in the correct order?

Easy to read, correct spelling and grammar?

Support documents included (lists, drawings, photos, letters)

65 pts - Achievement

How significant is/was the impact to club and community?

Did the Impact and activities match the Award criteria?

Did the project meet its objectives?

Is there a plan for ongoing maintenance?

15 pts – Participation

How many, how much, what proportion of the club and/or larger community were involved?

Is there funding and involvement from multiple sources?

15 pts - Record or Documentation

Do the supporting documents confirm, clarify, and/or enrich the readers' understanding of the project?

STATE AWARDS

(Revised November 2023)

RULES FOR STATE AWARDS

- 1. Awards year: January 1st to December 31st annually, unless stated otherwise.
- 2. Eligibility: Member clubs of The Garden Club Federation of Massachusetts, Inc.
- 3. Deadline: December 1st annually. All applications and supporting material must be submitted to the state awards chairman on or before this date.
- EXCEPTIONS: This does not apply to Flower Show achievement awards, Special Awards, and Award II-E, Civic Development and Historic Preservation Grants.
- 5. Application Form: All submissions shall use the State Awards cover sheet and application.
- 6. Source of form: Application is available on the GCFM website: www.gcfm.org
- 7. **Number of applications:** Clubs may apply for more than one award. However, the GCFM Awards Committee will only consider one submission per club for each award category.
- 8. Type of applications: Clubs may apply for State, New England Region, and National awards for the same project. Separate application forms are required for each submission and must be sent to the State Awards Chair for forwardins. Do not submit an exact duplicate application for more than one award.
- 9. EXCEPTIONS: Application is not required XI-C: Yearbook and XIII-B: Presidential Citation.
- 10. Number of awards granted: A GCFM club may receive all awards merited in any given year, provided all qualifications are met. A club may not receive the same award for two consecutive years.
- 11. Trophies: Per GCFM Board vote: If a trophy is awarded, a photo of the trophy will be given to the winner with the certificate of merit. Trophies will not be given out but may be borrowed for a special event.
- 12. NOTE: Grants, Flower Show Awards, Special Awards, and Scholarships are listed after the State Awards.
- 13. All award applications, except those with their own Scale of Points and Flower Show Award Applications, will be judged based on National Garden Club's Scale of Points.

Presentation 5 points
Achievement 65 points
Participation 15 points
Record or Documentation 15 points
100Points

Applications shall be judged according to club size determined by number of members including Active, Inactive, Honorary, Sustaining, etc.

Small Club 29 members and under Medium Club 30-59 members Large Club 60-99 members Extra Large Club 100 members and over
